

# FEATURED PROJECT

## Bus Rapid Transit-Phase II Port Authority of Allegheny County, PA

**Overview:** The Port Authority of Allegheny County adopted a Transit Development Plan (TDP). Included in the TDP was a recommendation for “Rapid Bus” service on nine Authority bus routes, eight of which were in a corridor connecting Downtown Pittsburgh, Uptown, Oakland and various eastern neighborhoods. This corridor has the highest transit ridership in the Pittsburgh metropolitan area. This project includes Alternatives Analysis (“AA”) / National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review, and, as an option, Preliminary Engineering (collectively, the Phase I BRT work) in the corridor, with the objective of determining a locally preferred alternative.

**Services provided:** Surveying, Right-of-way Design and Investigation, Geotechnical Engineering, Recommendations and Drilling, and Environmental Hazardous Waste study.
